Regarding SNAP benefits

The federal government has **approved a waiver** so that SNAP recipients can apply for **replacement benefits** for the food they lost during the storm.

You can call 2-1-1 to apply. Dial 2-1-1 and press 2.

The state is encouraging people to stay home and call 2-1-1 instead of going into their local HHS office, for obvious reasons.

Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) has suspended the work search requirement for unemployment benefits for the weeks of **February 15-19 and 22-28** and will "extend deadlines for any delays that occur due to the winter storm".

The Texas Department of Emergency Management (TDEM) has a form to self-report damage that will help them figure out what happened and build the numbers to support a FEMA declaration.
